



MA-PASS Privacy Policy

MA-PASS respects your privacy. We only collect, store and use your personal information for defined purposes. We use your information to support and enhance our relationship with you, help you set appointments, and maintain your listings. We do not sell your personal information and will not use any such information for profit. The data entered into the MA-PASS database is used for the sole purpose of setting appointments and will be later archived for the member's use. The member is free to delete part or all of the data or archive it. In the event of termination of account, the archived data is deleted along with the member's account. MA-PASS is committed to protecting your privacy and data. You may contact MA-PASS with any privacy questions or concerns you may have. We strive to ensure a high level of security and confidentiality.

Privacy and Data Security

At MA-PASS, your right to privacy and data security is a primary concern. When you call MA-PASS, we help you maintain control over your personal data on the Internet. Below are the guidelines we use for protecting the information you provide us during a visit to our Internet site (www.MAPASS.com) or when you call MA-PASS' call center.

MA-PASS' Privacy statement discloses the privacy guidelines for the MA-PASS Web site. The guidelines at this site are applicable only to this Web site. Information submitted solely in a business capacity is not covered by these guidelines.

MA-PASS only asks for specific types of personal information. For example, we request information from you when you:

- Register on MAPASS.com
- Schedule an appointment
- Edit a listing
- Request more information
- Provide feedback for showings

In each of the instances above, we may ask for your name, e-mail address, phone number, MLS agent ID, and office address. The information you provide will be kept confidential and used to support your customer relationship with MA-PASS. We want to help you quickly set appointments for showings. MA-PASS employees who have access to your information and customer information are required to keep the information confidential and not use it for any other purpose than to carry out the Services they are performing for you.

In addition, MA-PASS may be required to disclose personal information in connection with law enforcement, fraud prevention, regulation, and other legal action or if MA-PASS reasonably believes it is necessary to do so to protect MA-PASS, its customers, or the public.



MA-PASS will not disclose your personal information to any outside organization for use in marketing. Information regarding you (such as name, address and phone number) will not be given or sold to any outside organization for its use in marketing or solicitation. Your office information may be shared with agents of MA-PASS for the purpose of performing Services for you and other agents showing your listings.

You are solely responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your passwords or any account information. Please be careful and responsible whenever you're online. While we strive to protect your personal information, MA-PASS cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to us, and you do so at your own risk.
